

Medical Student Housing Policy University of Tennessee College of Medicine Chattanooga

The University of Tennessee College of Medicine Chattanooga leases 14, two-bedrooms apartments for UT medical student housing at the Hayden Place Apartments in Chattanooga.

If you are a medical student who has been approved for a student rotation in Chattanooga, please complete and submit the form below by clicking on the Submit Button at the bottom of the page after you have completed all fields. Submission does not guarantee housing, but the date of request is a factor. Priority for assigning the 14, two-bedroom apartments is:

Housing Assignment Guidelines

1. First Priority: 3rd year UT students
2. Second Priority: 4th year UT students
3. Third Priority: Visiting Medical Students

***Students are limited to a total of six four-week blocks in the apartments during the third and fourth years of rotations.**

*** If an M4 student is currently utilizing housing and has not used their 6 block maximum, they will not be displaced the following block in favor of a new M3 request.**

***Please note, if housing is at maximum capacity, the University will not be able to supplement any housing costs should a student find housing elsewhere during his/her rotation.**

***Students must include EACH block of housing they will need in their housing request form or submit separate requests for each rotation. Otherwise, the Chattanooga Campus cannot guarantee housing will be available.**

***Student spouses/significant others/children are not permitted to reside in the apartments with the medical student.**

***Pets are not permitted in the apartments.**

Since we frequently have more than 28 UT students, it helps if students from the Chattanooga area stay with friends or family to maximize available housing for other students.

- **UT** currently leases 14, two-bedroom apartments for our medical students to reside at Hayden Place Apartments near downtown Chattanooga.
- Two (2) students of the **same gender** are assigned to each apartment unless two married medical students are rotating in Chattanooga at the same time.
- Additionally, if UT Medical Students intend to complete most of their Clerkship and Elective rotations in Chattanooga, they should secure their own housing at their own expense. This helps to provide housing for those who may not have other options.

***We are not able to begin reviewing the student housing roster until thirty (30) days prior to the beginning of the rotation since students can change their schedules up until that point. You will be notified three weeks prior the start of your first block (or first returning block) in Chattanooga regarding housing availability.**

Note: The UTHSC College of Dentistry also leases two additional, two-bedroom apartments at Hayden Place to accommodate dental students rotating in Chattanooga at the Dodson Avenue Community Health Center for two week periods.
