

## Continuing Medical Education Services & Fees

Three (3) fees relate to the continuing medical education services provided by the University of Tennessee College of Medicine (UTCOM)

### 1) CME Activity Certification fees and 2) Certificate fees

**NOTE:** Activity Certification fees are assessed for each calendar year that the activity receives CME credit.

### 3) Grant Administration fee

The Office of CME charges a grant administration fee of 10% (or minimum of \$200) for each educational grant that must be submitted by our office.
